The 2014 lecture, held in collaboration with the University of Exeter, was delivered by Prof Tom Greggs on 7 May at the University of Exeter, and entitled *Priesthood, Christ and the Church*.

The trustees agreed the following changes to the scheme:

- 5. <u>Lecturer</u>. (a) The lecture shall *normally* be delivered by a presbyter, deacon or lay member of the Methodist Church who has not previously delivered the charity's lecture.
 (b) The lecturer shall be chosen by the managing trustees at least fifteen months before the proposed date of the lecture.
- 7. <u>Composition</u>. The body of managing trustees of the charity shall, when complete, consist of:
 - (i) the ex-officio trustee, as prescribed by Article 8 below;
 - (ii) five *four* presbyters or deacons of the Methodist Church in full connexion.
 - (iii) six four lay members of the Methodist Church.
- 8. <u>Ex-officio trustee</u>. (a) While there is a chair of the editorial committee of the Methodist Publishing House that person shall be the ex-officio trustee.
 (b) If at any time there is no such office, the President of the Conference of the Methodist Church shall have power from time to time to designate in place of that office some other office, and in the absence of such a designation the place of the ex-officio trustee shall be filled by an additional trustee.

The trustees report to the Conference that the Revd Gareth Powell retires from the Trust this year. The trustees present to the Conference the name of the Revd Mark Rowland as a new trustee.
