Reasoned Statements

(The number in brackets refers to the committee number in the list.)

The Revd Andrew Baker (47)	is a former Mission Partner who served in Grenada. He is Chair of the Overseas Service group, an advisory group for staff dealing with mission personnel in different parts of the world. One important aspect of that work is to advise on the training and formation needs for new Mission Partners. Andrew's presence on the SOCMS Advisory Council will further strengthen the lines of communication between advisers and practitioners.
Mr John Bell (16)	ex Vice-President of the Conference, Chair of the Stationing Review Group and has held many posts within the Church and brings a wide range of invaluable experience.
Mr Geoff Bond (26)	is a training officer for 2 districts: Birmingham and Wolverhampton and Shrewsbury. He has been in post since Sept '08. He was nominated to TSRE by his Regional Forum. His background is in social work, child protection, children, families work and management. Geoff was a manager for Young People's Services for Staffordshire and Stoke for many years and has been involved as a Trustee of several charities and also acted as a consultant to several social care organisations.
The Revd Dr Adrian Burdon (47)	is an ex-Mission Partner in Tonga, where he was principal of a theological college. 	Ethics, and PhD from Heythrop College. Her recent publications and current research interests include work on relating the incarnation to Business Ethics.
